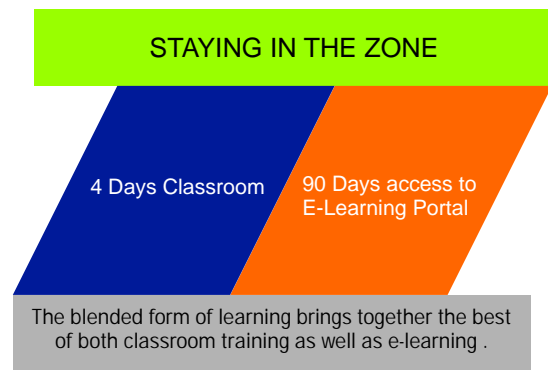

BLENDED LEARNING



Our experience has taught us that the probability of passing the PgMP® exam has a direct correlation to staying in the zone. The zone refers to a participant’s commitment and corresponding time spent in learning the concepts over a specified time period.

We have structured the preparation in such a way as to keep you motivated in the zone. This is done through a combination of class-room training, online training and virtual support until the point that you take the exam.

The PgMP® e-PREP (e-Learning) module is an excellent way of refreshing the concepts even after the class-room training. Eligibility & Application

Participants are required to have a total of 12,000 Hours (For Bachelor Degree holders) of experience in project and program management activities. The experience documented has to be aligned to PMI's definition and interpretation of Program and Project Management.

Providing Oversight & Support

Our support for the participant is for 3 months and within this period, we will monitor the progress and coordinate the expected timely deliverables. Our PgMP® Instructors will work closely with the participants to get their application submitted correctly. Errors and inconsistencies in the application will be identified and communicated before submission to PMI.

Panel Review

Once the application is submitted to PMI, a panel review follows. This involves an evaluation of the application by a PgMP® appointed by PMI. The evaluation is based on the relevance of the participant's experience with program management best practices.

Multiple Choice Exam

Following the successful completion of the panel review, the participant has to pass a 170 questions, 4 hour exam. This exam is based on the Program Management Standard second edition. Our PgMP® course covers the content needed to pass the PgMP® exam.

Multi Rater Assessment

Upon passing the exam, a multi rater assessment is initiated. This includes a 360 degrees feedback with 12 people providing inputs to PMI on your program management skills.

Aurora Green IT Inc

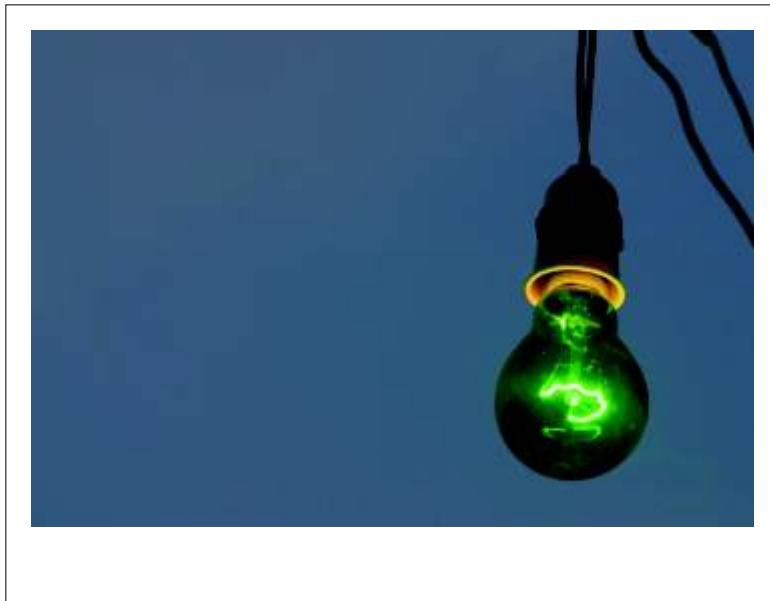
Aurora Inc is an Information Communications Technology company specializing in Software Development. Aurora Inc has over 2000 staff, mainly software designers and developers, 2 data centers and 6 regional offices. Senior management at Aurora Inc has authorized a Green IT program which involves moving Aurora Inc toward energy efficiency.

Green IT Program Goal

To increase energy efficiency by 20% within 2012 and comply to carbon emission targets of the country in which Aurora Inc operates. Aurora Inc expects to realize its energy efficiency targets by reducing power consumption, improving waste management, and improving work processes.

Projects under the Green IT Program

A Program is defined as a group of related projects managed in a coordinated manner. Projects that make up the Aurora Green IT Program

Project 1:
Data Center Power Consumption

Data center electricity usage contributes to 30% of total power consumption at Aurora Inc. A data center is a physical location with servers to host, process and distribute all information. These servers need electricity 24/7 to run without interruption. The physical location also needs constant electricity for the air-conditioning to cool the servers.

The project involves replacing the current servers with new energy efficient servers that consume lesser electricity and redesigning the layout of the data center to enhance cooling capabilities.

Project 2:
Office Building Facilities

Office buildings electricity usage contributes to 50% of total power consumption at Aurora Inc.

Buildings are major sites for electricity consumption. Energy is wasted in building due to poor planning and design. Lighting, air conditioning, hardware (PC's desktops, printers), elevators etc, are built for full capacity usage.

The project involves implementing occupancy based lighting, maximum use of daylight, automatic stand-by for hardware.

Project 3:
Virtualization

A major portion of Aurora Inc's operating costs involve business travel, training and office space.

The project involves implementing telecommuting and virtual options for conducting meetings, trainings and conferences. Work from home options are expected to reduce travel and thereby reduce carbon emissions.

Conducting trainings, meetings and workshops through remote online technologies is expected to reduce logistics associated with physical movement of people and goods.

Project 4:
Recycling & Waste Management

A major portion of Aurora Inc's used material is disposed through inefficient processes.

The project involves creating a paperless office and replacing carbon physical products with environmental friendly alternatives.

The project also involves increasing the life span of purchased products thereby reducing the amount of disposed end of life products.

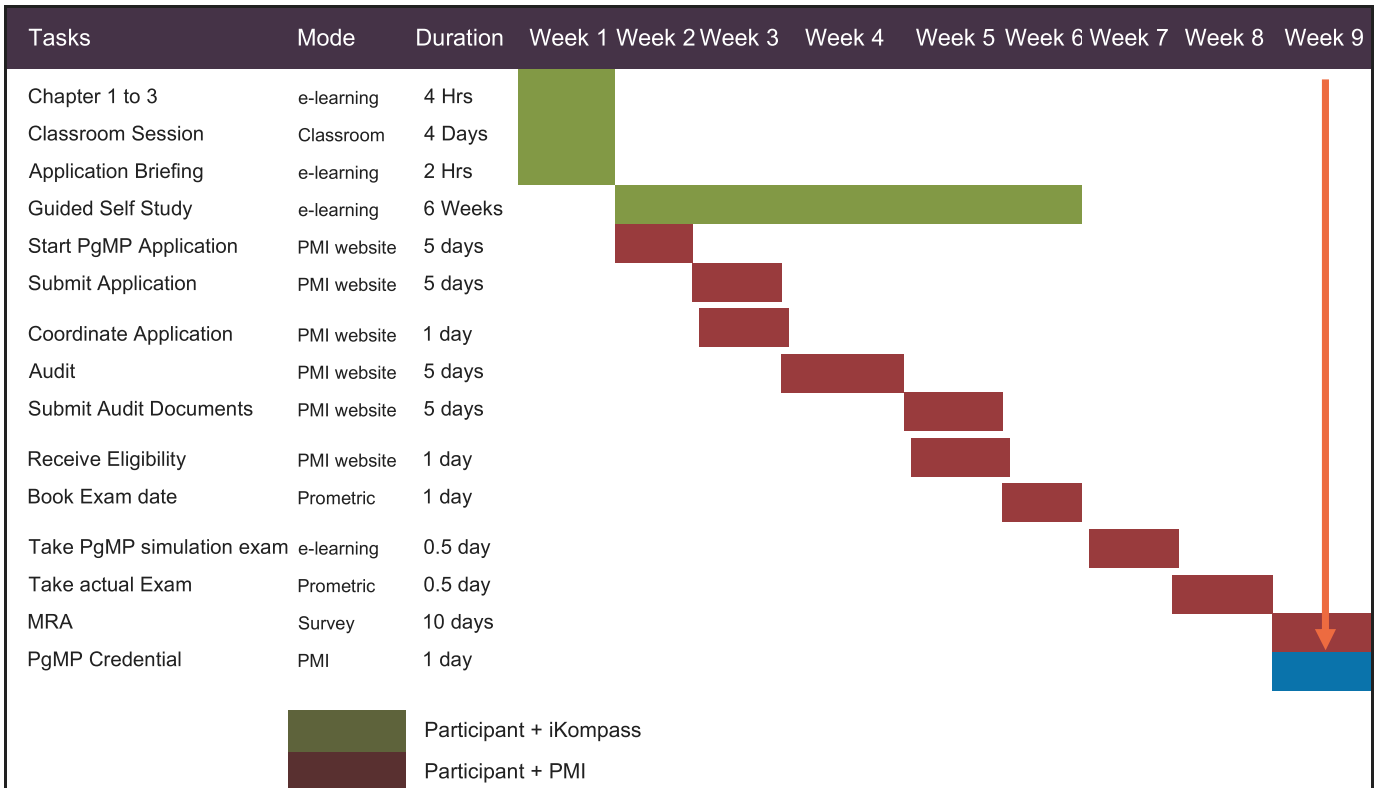
